

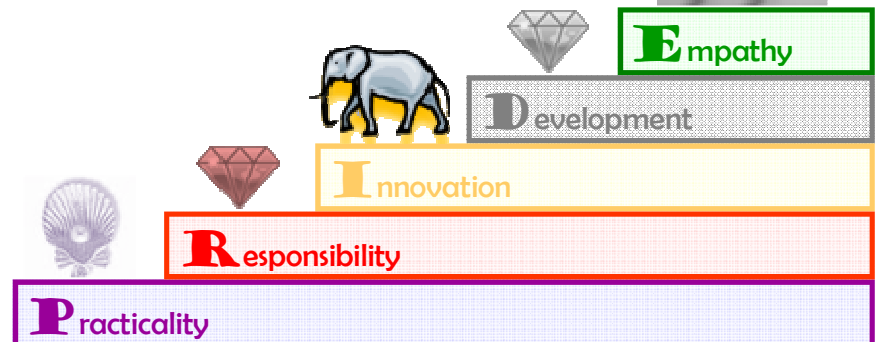
Your child has decided to work towards completing their **EMERALD PRIDE** Homework Award.

Academic

- Report on a school or local event and present to a local paper for publication - must include a photo, and be approved by Mr Norrish.
- Read at least 8 chapter books in a term
- Write a short story of at least 1500 words and share with your class
- Record a fact file on your favourite author
- Design a challenge of your own choice in another curriculum area



Service

- Prepare and cook a meal for six people that includes at least three courses
- Find an area at school that needs help and plan and design a way to improve it
- Prepare and enter six events at the Oxford A&P Show (or elsewhere) in addition to the entries completed at school
- Cook a meal for someone in need at their house, share it with them
- Design a challenge of your own choice



Giving

- Find someone in the community who needs your support and help them out for the year
- Design and develop a garden pest control that is environmentally healthy
- Organise and raise funds for a charity or our school
- Participate in the 40 hour famine and raise at least \$50
- Design a challenge of your own choice



The Arts

- Perform a piece of music on an instrument to your class
- Create a piece of art using multi-media and display in your class
- Make up a dance, jump jam routine or haka to a piece of music, teach it to others, and present it to your class
- Write and perform a piece of drama to your class
- Design a challenge of your own choice



Physical Activity:

- Take responsibility for an animal's welfare for a term
- Join a sports club and play a team game for a season
- Go on a two night tramp with a family member



- Make up a game for the family to play on the weekend, and get their responses
- Design a challenge of your own choice
