This means you need to help them to choose one task from each box, and support them to complete the task.

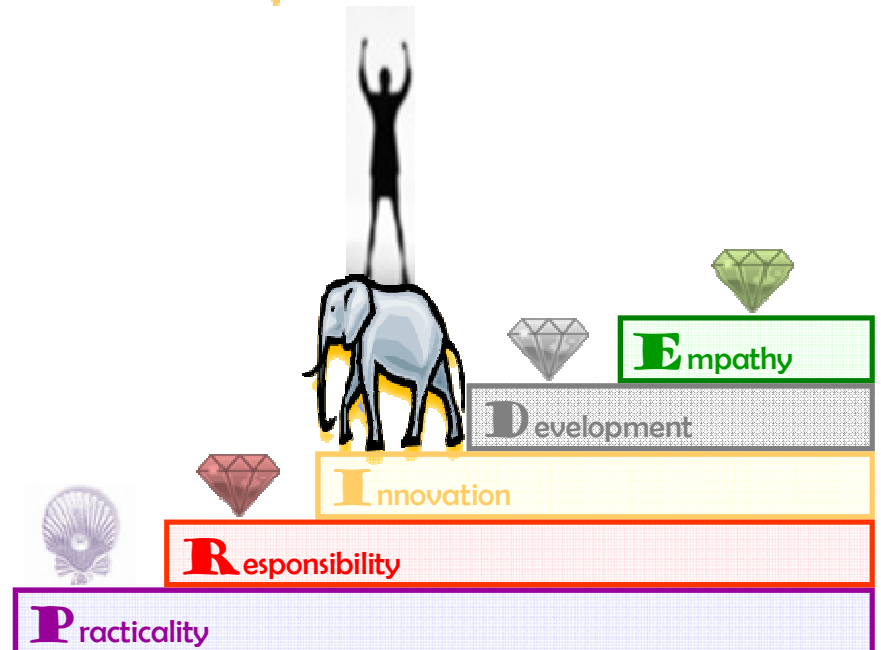
They need to complete a total of **NINE** tasks to graduate from this level.

## Academic

- Read at least 6 chapter books in a term
- Present a report to junior school assembly on a school or community event
- Complete one entire numeracy passport over the year
- Research an area of your choice and present it to our assembly in a creative way
- Present a four minute speech to your class on a topic of your choice
- Design a challenge of your own choice in another curriculum area



## Service

- Prepare and cook dinner for your family
- Care for a garden area of the school for a term (ask Mr Pulley for a suitable area)
- Prepare and enter four events at the Oxford A&P Show (or elsewhere) in addition to the entries completed at school
- Take on a responsibility to help the middle school for two terms
- Design a challenge of your own choice



## Giving

- Meet with an elderly person every term and do something special for them to help them
- Participate in the 20 hour famine or other school fundraiser (e.g. spellathon, mathsathon) and raise at least \$30
- Grow some vegetables from seed to give away to others
- Organise and raise a donation for the charity of your choice
- Design a challenge of your own choice



## The Arts

- Construct a three-dimensional art work
- Present a play to the middle school (learned and costumed)
- Choreograph a piece of music for a class to use in Jump Jam time and teach it to the class, or perform at Year Six Graduation.
- Join the choir and sing in the Christchurch Primary Schools Music Festival
- Design a challenge of your own choice



## Physical Activity:

- Organise a series of 3 lunchtime activities for children
- Join a sports club and play a team game for a season



- Tramp to the top of a local mountain with a family member
- Help out with coaching a junior sport team for a season
- Design a challenge of your own choice
