## Academic

- Present a written report to go on the wall in class
- Read at least 4 chapter books in a term
- Complete 6 aspects of your numeracy passport
- Research an area of your choice and present it to your class in a creative way
- Present a two minute speech to your class on a topic of your choice
- Design a challenge of your own choice in another curriculum area



## Service

- Prepare breakfast for your family
- Find an area at school that needs tidying and tidy it up
- Prepare and enter two events at the Oxford A&P Show (or elsewhere) in addition to the entries completed at school
- Be a responsible classroom monitor or take responsibility for an area of the classroom for a term
- Design a challenge of your own choice



## Giving

- Visit and help an elderly person twice in a term
- Plant a vegetable garden (or large pot) and grow three vegetables for your family to eat
- Participate in the 20 hour famine or other school fundraiser (e.g. spellathon, mathsathon) and raise at least \$10
- Organise and raise a donation for the charity of your choice
- Design a challenge of your own choice



## The Arts

- Make a model or carving or sculpture and show your class
- Present a play to your class (learned and costumed)
- Make up a dance or haka to a piece of music, and present it to your class (can be done with others)
- Learn a magic trick or circus act and present it to your class
- Design a challenge of your own choice



## Physical Activity:

- Organise a game for junior pupils at lunch
- Join a sports club and play a team game for a season



- Go on a two hour bush walk with family/friends
- Learn a new sport and explain and demonstrate it to your class
- Design a challenge of your own choice
