LEVEL 2 - YEAR 5

Academic

- Read at least 5 chapter books in a term
- Complete 10 aspects of your numeracy passport
- Present a report on an event at school or in the wider community
- Research an area of your choice and present it to your class in a creative way
- Present a three minute speech to your class on a topic of your choice
- Design a challenge of your own choice in another curriculum area



Service

- Prepare a picnic for your family
- Find an area at school and keep it litter free for a whole term
- Prepare and enter three events at the Oxford A&P Show (or elsewhere), in addition to the entries completed at school
- Take on a responsibility that helps the middle school for a whole term
- Design a challenge of your own choice



Giving

- Visit and help an elderly person twice in a term for two terms
- Grow some vegetables to give away
- Participate in the 20 hour famine or other school fundraiser (e.g. spellathon, mathsathon) and raise at least \$20
- Look after siblings in some manner to help your family
- Design a challenge of your own choice



The Arts

- Produce a recycled materials art work
- Write a short play and present it to your class (learned and costumed)
- Make up a dance or haka, teach it to others, then present it to the middle school
- Join the choir and sing in the Christchurch Primary Schools Music Festival
- Design a challenge of your own choice



Physical Activity:

- Organise games for junior pupils for two lunchtimes
- Join a sports club and play a team game for a season



- Go on a four hour bush walk with family/friends
- Practice a new skill and demonstrate it to your class
- Design a challenge of your own choice
