<b>Jackets</b>	Appropriate wet weather jacket, preferably navy or black				Plain navy or black outdoor jacket for outdoor wear.				
<b>Hats and scarves</b>	Navy wide brimmed sunhat or bucket hat				Y7 & 8 should wear a navy/black wide brimmed sunhat, bucket hat or cap – no logos. Y9-13 are encouraged to wear them. Black or royal blue plain beanie and black or royal blue scarf can be worn outside in winter.				
<b>Sports</b>	Year 5 & 6 - Plain black shorts are available from The Warehouse, Rangiora. Year 5 & 6 - OAS Red Sports top is only available through Mainland Uniforms, available online				Plain black shorts are available from The Warehouse, Rangiora. <b>Under-garments</b>	Any clothing layers worn beneath the school uniform must not be visible.								
<b>Jewellery</b>	The only jewellery that students may wear is one small plain ring, one wrist watch, one discrete necklace, and unobtrusive studs or sleepers in their ears. Body/facial piercing is discouraged for safety reasons. <b><i>Some classes may require the removal of these items for safety reasons.</i></b>								
<b>Facial Hair</b>	This is unacceptable at any level of the school. Clean shaven appearance is required at school.								
<b>Suppliers</b>	<b>Year 1 – 6:</b> - All items are available only from The Warehouse in Rangiora. <b>Year 7 – 13</b> - The uniform supplier for these items is Mainland Distributors, Wairakei Road, Christchurch, Phone 03 360 3037, except for the boys grey banded socks which are available from Oxford Pharmacy, Main Street, Oxford.
