Background

The Education Review Office reviews schools that are signatories to the *Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2021* established under section 534 of the Education and Training Act 2020.

Findings

The school is a signatory to the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice 2016 established under section 534 of the Education and Training Act 2020. The school has attested that it complies with all aspects of the Code and has completed an annual self-review of its implementation of the Code.

At the time of this review there were eight international students attending the school, and no exchange students.

Oxford Area School provides a high level of professional and pastoral support to international students.

The International Dean assists with academic and school needs. The Homestay Coordinator meets students on arrival and is readily available to help and guide students to adapt to a new culture and new environment. Students have regular contact with the Homestay Coordinator.

Students attend an orientation programme and receive targeted English Language (ESOL) assistance according to their needs. There are many school subjects to choose from with the help of their dean. There are opportunities for outdoor education and equine studies.
